**LOCATION**

Our Weekend Workshops take place at our North Junction Street Campus.

**FEES**

The workshop fees cover professional tuition, use of studios and equipment, and all core materials, with the exception of extra quantities of precious metals for jewellery workshops. Also included, where applicable, are the cost of models and entrance fees to venues visited as part of the workshop. There are no hidden costs.

**CANCELLATION**

Leith School of Art reserves the right to cancel courses if the circumstances dictate. If this happens you will be offered an alternative course, or a full or partial refund of your deposit and fees. If you cancel more than three weeks before the start of the class, your fees will be refunded minus a £15 administration charge. If you have to cancel your place less than three weeks before the start of the workshop, your fees will not normally be refundable. Non-attendance of the workshop due to illness or personal circumstances does not provide the right to a refund or credit. However, in exceptional circumstances we may be able to offer a full or partial refund. In this instance, we request that you outline the circumstances in writing to the Head of Finance and Operations.
