

# DAY & EVENING COURSES Terms and Conditions 2018/2019

# LOCATIONS

We have five studios across two campuses: 25 North Junction Street and the St James' Campus, 11a John's Place (off Leith Links). Please note the location of your course when booking.

#### FEES

The course fees cover tuition, use of studios and equipment, and all materials and lectures, with the exception of extra quantities of precious metals for jewellery classes. Also included, where applicable, are the cost of models and entrance fees to venues visited as part of the class. THERE ARE NO HIDDEN COSTS.

#### PAYMENT

A deposit of £50 is required with your booking and the balance of fees is due three weeks prior to the start of the course. You can pay by BACS transfer, credit/debit card, in cash, by cheque or online at www. LeithSchoolofArt.co.uk. Cheques should be made payable to Leith School of Art.

# **DISCOUNTS**

We have a limited number of concessionary places available on our courses. Please contact the School for further information. School pupils are eligible for a 15% discount. Please note, only one discount can be claimed for each booking.

### CANCELLATION

Leith School of Art reserves the right to cancel courses if the circumstances dictate. If this happens you will be offered an alternative course or a full refund of your deposit and fees. If you cancel more than three weeks before the start of the course, your fees will be refunded minus a £25 administration charge. If you have to cancel your place less than three weeks before the start of the class, your fees will not normally be refundable. Non-attendance of the class due to illness or personal circumstances does not provide the right to a refund or credit. However, in exceptional circumstances we may be able to offer a full or partial refund. In this instance, we request that you outline the circumstances in writing to the Business Manager.
